Lexues was the first company in Japan to develop a genuine online collaboration service, entitled "Team Gear".

The service was released free of charge in December 1998 and was designed to facilitate various fields of communication among businesses, groups, communities and families, with the goal of contributing to their creative activities.







Since the release of the cellular version of Team Gear with "i-mode" (1999), we have concentrated on developing web application services for cellular telephones.

*i-mode : An Internet services for mobile phones that generated an entirely new kind of information culture.







We have developed the new products with the experiences of Team Gear for cellular phones;

- Pure Axis in 2001 for converting web sites for cellular phones
- Pure Axis ASP in 2002, ASP version of Pure Axis
- Pure Picture in 2003, an automatic image conversion ASP service for cellular phones.

These services have been employed by a number of prestigious companies including TV Asahi Inc., Nikko Cordial Securities

Inc., and leading research-portal site companies such as goo and i-Town Page.





After the release of Team Gear, we strengthened our position in the market by developing unique ASP/SaaS services through expertise gained in providing services from our own data-processing center.













In April 2009, we brought our new web communication service "Amebee" to Web2.0 Expo San Francisco.


